### How you can help

Early support is the best way of reducing the risk of involvement in violent activity.

Sometimes, it's as simple as listening in a caring way without judgement. Other times, you might need a referral to others in the community who can help.

Talking it over with someone trained to help is a great first step.

**Step Together** is a helpline and online service staffed by trained counsellors. We provide a safe space to assist people who know someone that may be headed down the path to violent extremism.
